The aim of this exhibition is to see how contemporary artists respond to contemporary world and to connect them and their work with an wider audience.

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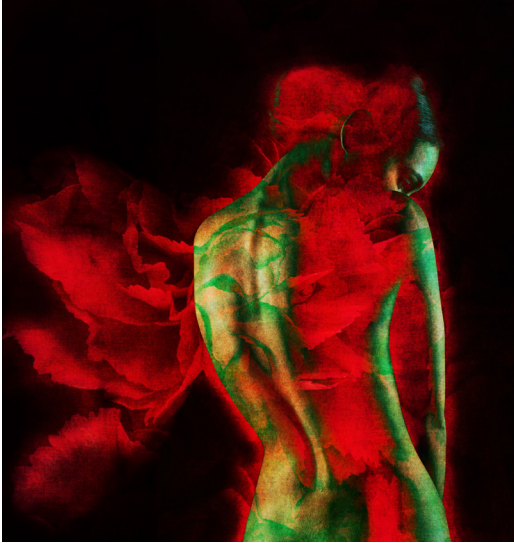
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VANESSA WENWIESER



Vanessa Wenwieser's work places the female into the centre of her imagination, she liberates them from the typical male gaze and brings her female perspective to the forefront. In her artworks, women are seen as beings with minds, emotions and intuitively powerful. Using the figure and allusive storytelling elements Wenwieser examines the gap between appearance and being. Feelings are exhibited naked and vulnerable, she explores them in an imaginative and beautiful way, trying to make people see the transcendent.

Her aim is to pull the viewer inside her pictures to make them inhabit her other-worldly depictions. These artworks, show what particular transformative emotions and feelings could look like. Be it love, metamorphosis, imagination, healing, regaining lost strength and the afterlife. Wenwieser uses space to create feeling of the sublime, when describing strong emotional places of the soul. At the age of five she had her first contact with brushes and the connection has lasted until the present day, maintaining an illusion for the colours that grew inside her like the foam that the boats sail on her canvases. When she creates her compositions she connects with the most intimate part of her being, the brushes are like an extension of her soul and her fingers sway in her air transmitting all that she carries inside. Joy Poet is an artist who creates to ease the traffic in her mind, soul and spirit.

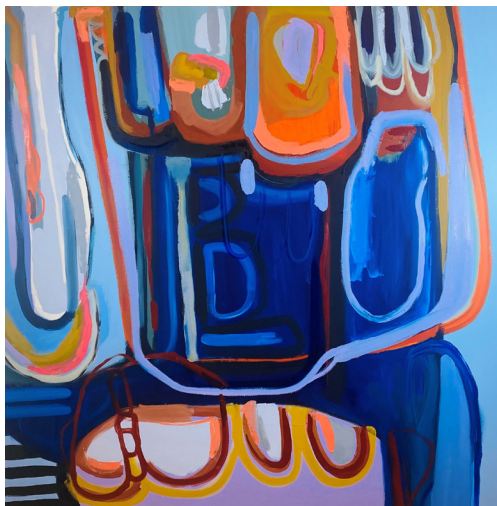
She is a like well that runs for thousands of mile.

Having a long history in creative expression, Jael has been formally trained as a graphic designer, which enables her to envision in things spatially and in proportion. She has also completed the New York Interior Design course, which has developed the ability to see things dimensionally and to be able to visualize balance and harmony in a space. This has been extremely important in planning and developing layers and colors in my Abstract Works. The passion to paint, emerged from "paint therapy" as a means of self-expression that was more electronically disconnected from computers and more hands on. This passion and emotional expression has been a consistent theme in her works, both in the intuitive nature of her process and in the titles she selects. My name is Dimitris Kiriakos and I am a painter and a psychoanalyst.

I am 48 years old and I live in Greece. I have studied Medicine, Psychiatry, Psychoanalysis, and Painting. My paintings are another way of me analyzing / understanding human nature and myself. I paint human internal/ unconscious life that can not be observed, but shapes everything that can be witnessed in human action. I paint in an abstract way through an action-reaction dialogue to produce a work of art spontaneous, intuitive and very close to its unconscious origins. In this way, I strive to depict on canvas various complex human mental and emotional states of our psychic life. That is another way for me to connect with others, to connect with the world: relating through my art. That is the unifying nature of art after all. It binds us all together in shared experiences through time and space.



COURTNEY B ROPP

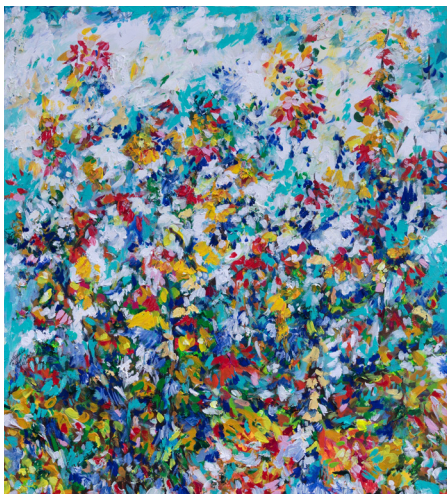


Courtney B Ropp is an American digital media artist based in Tromsø, Norway. She is a US Army veteran, who spent six and a half years as a Combat Documentation/Production Specialist (Combat Camera). She has had the opportunity to work in a variety of different roles from working with high profile individuals at the Pentagon, documentation of performances at her local theatre, to producing and directing her own narrative films.

Growing up as a child of a US Army veteran, Courtney has moved over 40 times and experienced many different cultures. This has promoted an interest in societies' influence on how we are expected to move through life. Her work is an exploration of sociological and anthropological behaviors through the lens of visual documentation. She captures natural reactions and behaviors to social norms while experimenting with the intent to expose what is at the core of the human condition.

MICHAL AVRECH

Michal Avrech is an internationally renowned award-winning artist based in Israel. Her work is exhibited, screened, and published nationally as well as in the United States, Asia, and Europe, notably at Florence Biennale, International Biennale of Etruria, Art Expo NY, MAMAG Modern art museum, and the FIAC Art Fair in Paris. In addition to painting, she also works as an art therapist for at-risk youth and belongs to the Israeli Professional Visual Art Association and International Association of Art. After earning a BA in Fine Arts and an MA in Art Therapy, Avrech now paints independently and is also featured in galleries around the world. Avrech describes her distinctive abstract paintings as being both dynamic and universal, inviting viewers to reflect upon their inner and outer worlds. She uses fast, expressive brush strokes without careful planning, like a painting in the consciousness of a dream. Her vivid abstractions are translated through an impressionistic and expressive lens using intense colours on large canvases. In a 2021 critique of Avrech's art, Davide Pugnana writes, "Avrech's expressive research reveals a strong stylistic cohesion..."



BIANCA APOLLONIO



Born in the South of Italy in 1993. Throughout her childhood she discovered reading and wordsmith as powerful tools to explain her world, herself and what leads a plant or individual to flourish in a certain way rather than another. In 2016, she graduated in Rome, all whilst she approached photography. She moved to Paris to continue her studies, where she developed an interest combining research in the humanities with photography and writing. In recent years, she has fostered her path of cultural decoding and has used performance to communicate with a wide audience through "Happening" (2020). She collaborates with the online magazine *Pensiero Mediterraneo* and works on an independent project. "Âmes de Paname" (Souls of Paris) is a human cartography of Paris, that merges photography, research and writing, and tells the story of the soul of Paris through the stories of individuals born between the 1930s and 1950s.

Skyler Yixian Liu is an artist and printmaker whose works explore identity, memory and trauma. Skyler graduated with a Bachelor of Illustration and Visual Media from the London College of Communication (UAL) before undertaking an MA Print at the Royal College of Art. MELISSA USHTCHENKO



"Melissa Ushtchenko is a Canadian photographer who has been creating self-portraits since 2020. She is currently exploring at the intersection of self and other - how we see ourselves, how we've come to see ourselves through others' eyes, and how we perform our chosen or assumed identities - alone and/or with others. The Voyeur series builds on the self/other relationship and plays with the juxtaposition of observer and observed, watcher and watched, seer and seen. Through self-portraits, these concepts are taken even further, as the observer is also the one being observed. In this sense, we transcend "self" and "other" and merge the two identities, creating an infinite loop of reflection.

DELYAN NIKOLAEV BALEV

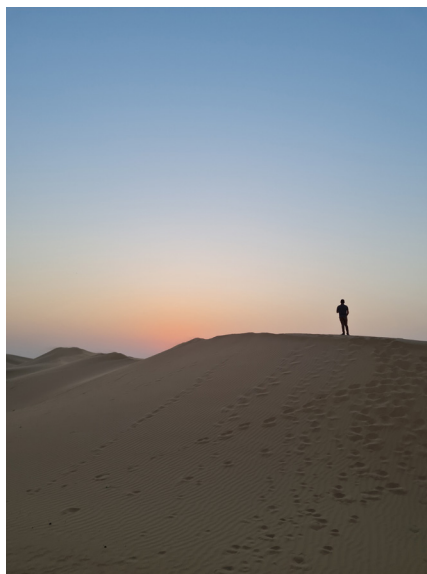
Nationality: Bulgaria, European Union

CHENGYAN SUN



This story — about a boy's exploration of gender and sexuality — is a metaphor for my personal experience. In this era of apparent openness, some people still doubt what they recognise in themselves, which may come from the influence of their family, or from a lack of sex education. I also hope that those who feel pressure because of self doubt can face themselves bravely without shame and find their true self.

"I used photography, reflecting on its 'fuzziness' and its role in memory and identity. For me, the camera is a tool to record the real world, and photography is a secondary version of reality. It is instantaneous, calm and flowing. Through this process, I reconstructed a memory of the past to form a metaphorical story."

BOJKO JERMAN

I work in a special technique, hand silver engraving in painted aluminium, which is a variation of the most famous old graphic technique (etching). The appearance of the artwork depends on the type and direction of the light. I developed this original technique while studying architecture, a field in which I worked professionally until recent retirement when I resumed artistic activity.

VICTORIA GOLYSHEVA

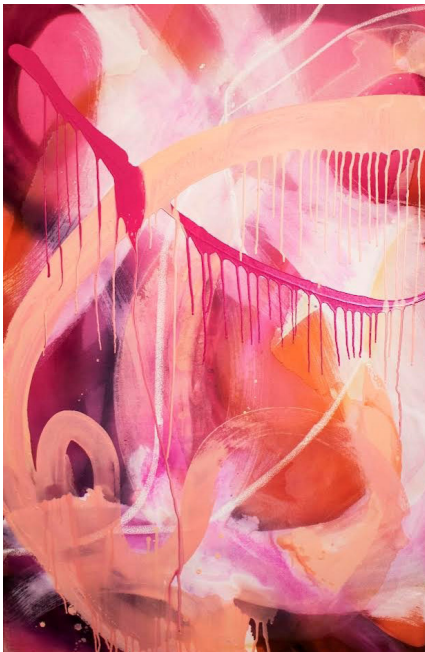

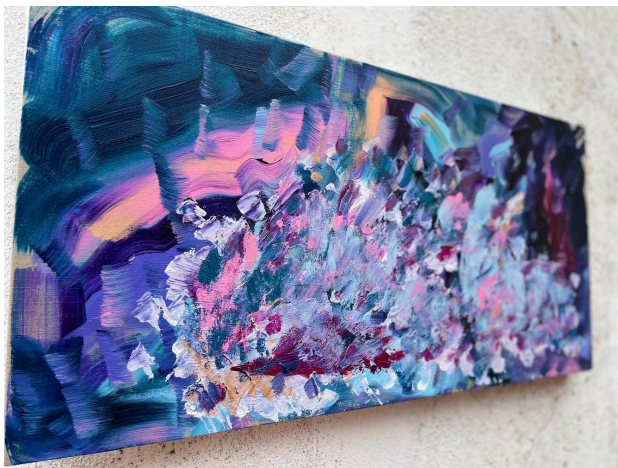
NICOLE MELNICKY

JIANG LILI

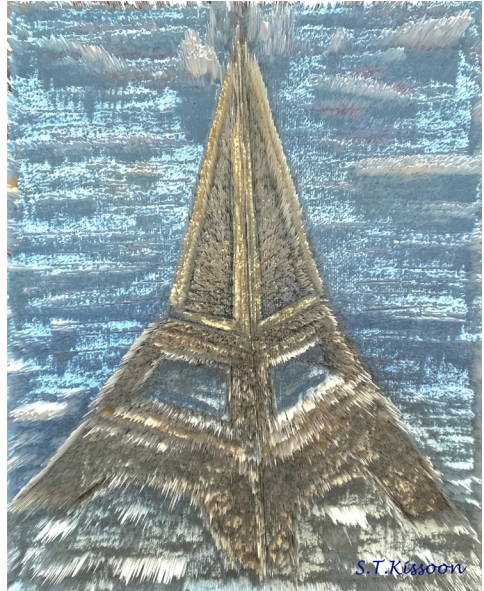

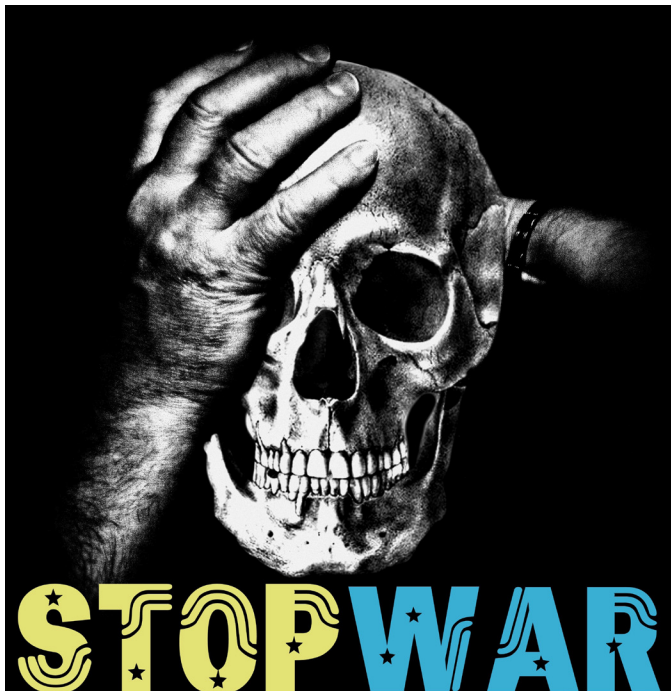
TARA KISSOON

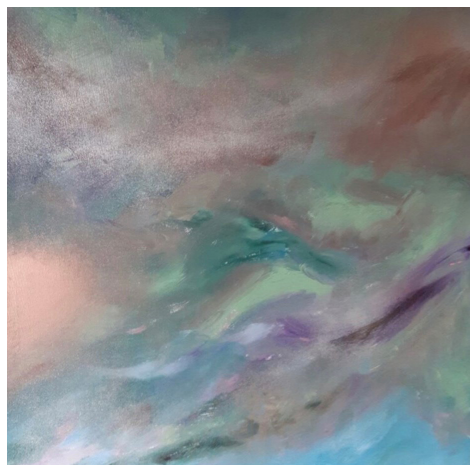
NAPASIO

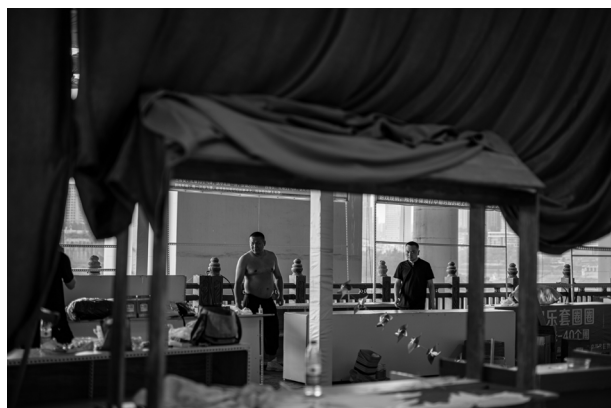

PHILIPPE RUDAZ



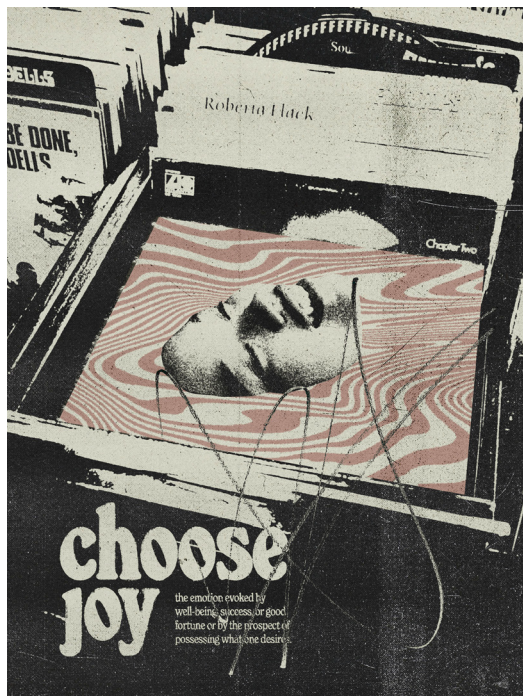

MARIIA TOKAR



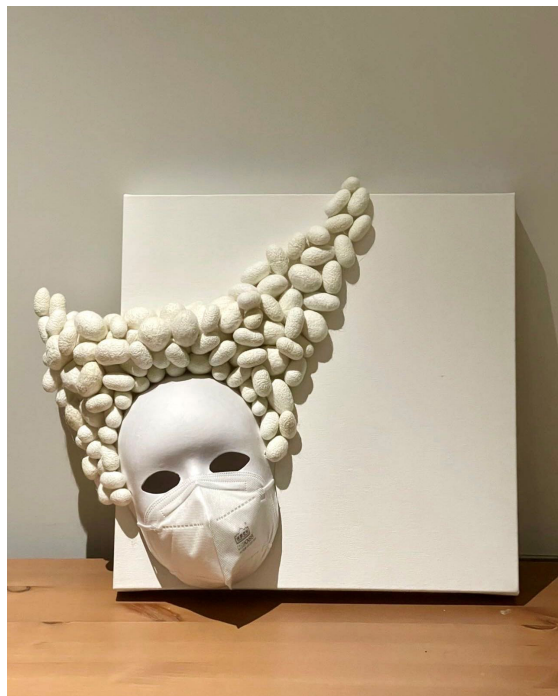

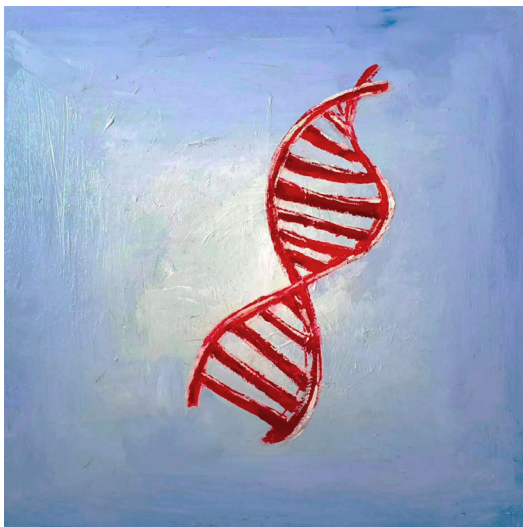

LIZZIE JAYNE



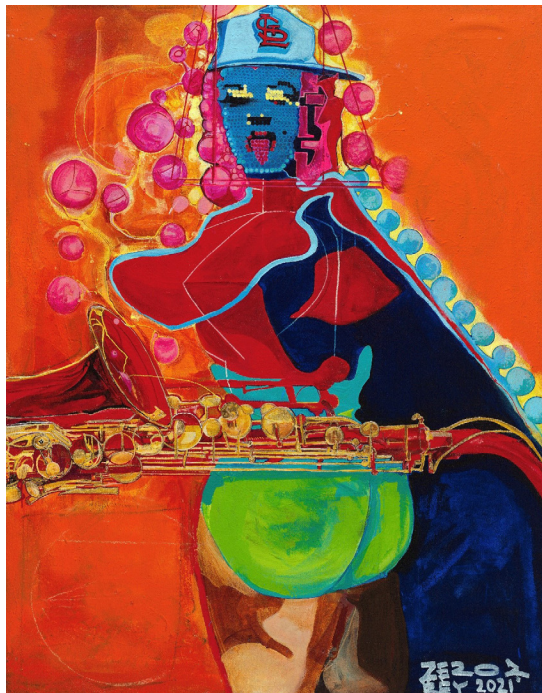

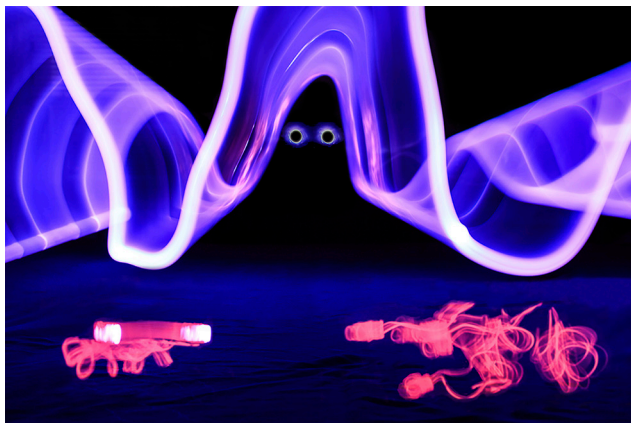
LEOKE

BETTINA NEWBERY



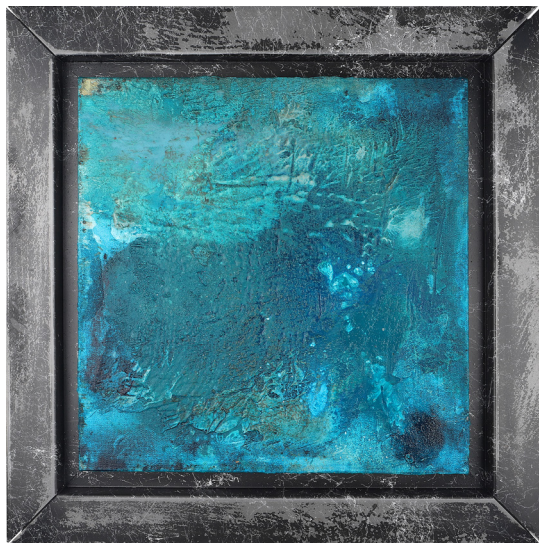

Leroy Skalstad is a disabled combat veteran who's favorite genre is street portraiture.



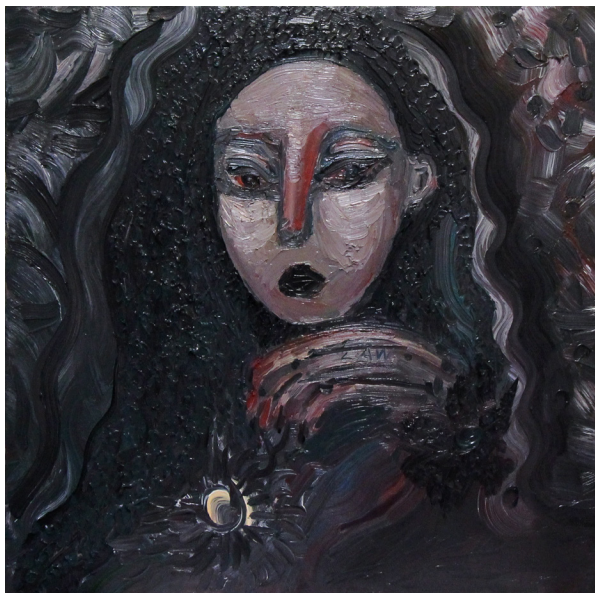
FREDDIE REILLY

KATHARINA RUBIN



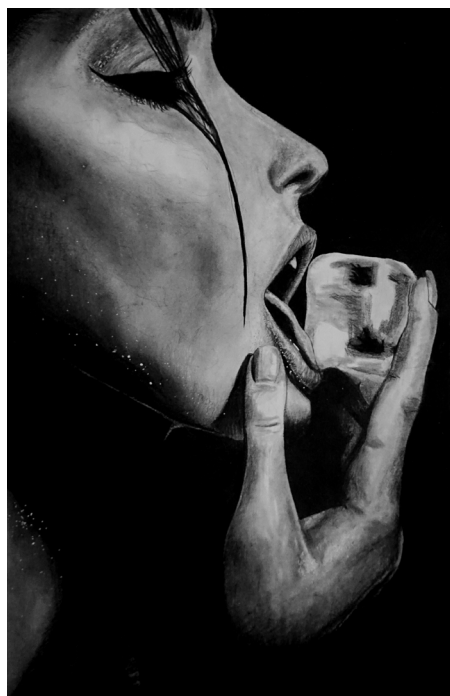
